Have you ever wondered what goes on behind the scenes in the newsroom of the country's most popular nightly broadcast?

Channel 4's must-watch nightly news is presented by married power couple Gali and Ethan Arazi. She's sensitive and warm; he's sharp and professional. Together they are the face of the channel's news empire, putting their personal touch on each day's news and delivering it into people's living rooms with a smile each evening. What the viewers don't know, however, is that when the cameras turn off, chaos rules.

What Gali Arazi believes to be the biggest scoop of the year – an alleged rape by a highly positioned judge - turns out to be the story that sends her plummeting to failure. When the judge commits suicide, the overwhelming backlash sends Gali into a tailspin from which she cannot recover.
